

WHAT WE DO WITH SPORT

to play a sport	when we speak about games in which one tries to win against another person or team	to play football, tennis, handball
to do a sport	when we speak about a sport that is not a team sport (it has a more general meaning)	to do aerobics, gymnastics, exercise
to be into a sport (informal)	when we speak about being interested or absorbed in sport	She is into jogging.
to go A-ing (to go swimming / skiing)	when we speak about sport activity, which is not done professionally	<i>'Jack goes swimming</i> ' means that he is not a professional swimmer. It's his hobby and he doesn't do it regularly.
to (to swim, to ski, etc.)	when we speak about sport, which is done professionally / competitively	<i>'Jack swims</i> ' means that he is a professional swimmer who takes part in competitions.

Some sport verbs are **never** used with **play** / **do** / **go** (to box, to wrestle, etc.).
